There are several items we need to discuss; first, I have been informed by Pinellas County that they are fluorinating our water starting March 1st. I have been told that all regulatory agencies have been notified and if you should have any questions, you can use the web site:

Second, yes, the whole reason I write this is to inform you about NPDES; it's one of the requirements for permitting. So, I'll hop on my soap box to tell you to please be mindful when thinking of our storm sewer system, yes, our storm sewer system. Now I know this is not an interesting subject to some but think about what you put in and on your lawn, sidewalks, driveways and the street in front of your house. All this has the potential to end up in our storm sewers and eventually the oceans of our State. Now your friendly Public Works department has installed a number of baffle boxes which separate pollutants before heading down stream to bodies of water and we are proud of this, but you can help us by thinking ahead and asking yourself, "Do I really need this chemical on my lawn?" or "Can I get by without using bleach when I pressure wash?" Little things like this can go a long way to preserve our waters. OK, thanks, I'll hop down now and bring up our last topic of discussion.

I said several, more than two, so here is the third topic. The city of Belleair Bluffs has filed for cooperative funding again from SWFWMD for another road reconstruction project. This project is another in a long line that is improving our streets and drainage. 
